Auckland Council Te Kaunihera o Tāmaki Makaurau

Stats – as of 07 Sept 2022

- There are 16773 active compliance schedules in the Auckland region.
- The team process approx. 320 BWoF renewals per week
- 40% of these renewals involve Reports in-lieu
- 20% require further information or clarification



Top RFI Items

- 1. 12A forms incorrectly filled out or incorrect details
- 2. Missing documents
- 3. Reports in-lieu identifying defects
- 4. Added or removed Specified Systems without Form 11





A review of our reports show we have a net average increase of 8 compliance schedules per week.

That's a total of 392 new compliance schedules in a year

Online submissions


In June this year we went live with an online portal which enables you to submit BWoFs online

You can now submit the following via our online system:


- 1. BWOF renewals

- 3. Form 11 applications


















Positives



BWOF Audits 2022 - 2023

 20% of buildings to be audited annually (approx. 3400 audit year)



- We are currently prioritising "high risk" buildings. *E.g. backpackers, childcare centres and boarding houses*
- Please ensure the owner/building manager keeps inspection and maintenance records on site.
- We can accept these electronically (QR codes are great and we're in favour of this).
- Our auditors can be contacted to discuss requirements and determine what works for you and for them.




Expired BWOFs

- We have a process for expired BWoFs. Working hand in hand with CI team.
- We send reminder letters advising a BWoF is about to expire.
- Our Compliance Investigations team call the owner/contact person before issuing an infringement. Approx. 95% compliance rate after an infringement is issued.
- Our focus is ensuring buildings are safe for the public and ensuring the BWoF is up to date is part of that.
- We need to make building owners aware of their obligations under the Building Act.

Future state



- Dependent on outcome from MBIEs building consent review BWoFs may become a BCA function.
- We see in the future combined IQP registers will be necessary. We see this as
 a great opportunity to share info and resources. E.g. a north Island IQP
 register or even a national register.
