# Course 1: Building Regulatory Environment for Building Compliance

Gain core skills and knowledge to apply New Zealand's building regulatory framework. It covers key legislation such as the Building Act 2004, Building Regulations, and Fire and Emergency NZ Acts, and explores how these relate to roles, responsibilities, and processes in the built environment.

- **Duration:** 5 weeks for course 1
